



Back to School Fun! Pencil Pal Petal Pouch

This is not the full pattern - you will need the Petal Pouch Pattern to make this Pouch!



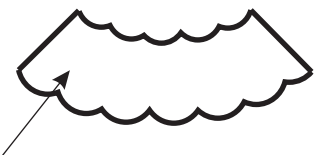
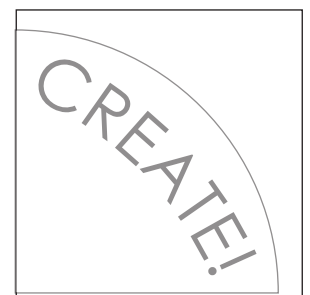
Supplies:

- Start with the Supply list from Petal Pouch Pattern (PQD-219) - including the pattern!
- 5x7 Hoop
- Medium-weight Tear-away Stabilizer
- Tan Fabric for Wood Appliques
- Temporary Spray Adhesive for embroidery
- Machine Embroidery Thread

How to turn your Petal Pouch into a Pencil Pouch!

Cutting steps - instead of cutting out shape B for the corner, cut a 5" square.

1. Follow the pattern Step 1.
2. Before beginning step 2, go to poorhousequilt designs.com, go to the Contact tab and fill in the contact form. Be sure to type in the correct email address! In the message, tell us that you want the CREATE! file for machine embroidery. We will email them to you.
3. Hoop with Medium Tear-way and stitch out the placement for the 5" square. Using temporary spray adhesive, place the corner square inside the placement stitching.
4. Stitch out the lettering.
5. Align the Shape B template with the bottom left hand corner of the of the embroidered corner square as shown. Cut the outer fabric away and proceed with step 2.
6. After Step 6, add the "wood" applique at the pointy ends of the appliques. This shape is slightly oversized so that you can adjust. Applique in place. Finish the pattern as written!



Pencil Wood shape - Prepare and cut out 7 fusible applique shapes - I used a tan fabric for this.
