Tips for the *Fold'n Stitch Wreath*

The Fold'n Stitch Wreath is a simple project - follow these **tips** for a faster finish!

1. **This is not the pattern** - the following are tips that you can use **with** the purchased pattern. This tips page contains no fabric requirements, no cutting instructions, and no sewing instructions - those are all in the purchased pattern.

5. Know which fabrics will appear where - look at Figure 1 on your pattern.
6. Using a directional print for the appliques? You may want to cut them at 45° and position design carefully during assembly.
7. Before turning your squares to the right side, trim the corners at a diagonal to reduce bulk.
6. Use a walking foot or open-toe foot when appliqueing so you can see where you are going.
